He Ako Hiringa is a programme delivered by Matui Ltd, a joint venture of health communication company The Health Media and health data company Airmed.


He Ako Hiringa aims to promote the responsible use of medicines in primary care, in line with PHARMAC's goal of achieving medicine access equity.

By focusing on conditions amenable to treatment with medicines, we hope to have the biggest impact on the health outcomes of our priority populations. The conditions we will focus on are:




What is medicine access equity?

Medicine access equity is where everyone has a fair opportunity to access funded medicines to attain their full health potential.


Certain population groups experience higher rates of health inequities and face bigger barriers than others when it comes to accessing medicine.
